Social Worker-LMFT / LCSW

The Licensed Mental Health Professional, LCSW or LMFT, provides psychosocial assessment, crisis intervention, group, individual and family therapy, case management, and discharge planning.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES: (may include, but not limited to the following)

- Works with the interdisciplinary team in the development and implementation of individualized treatment plans.
- Plans and implements appropriate group, family, and individual therapy.
- Maintains cooperative working relationships and effective communication with local law enforcement, county personnel, community resources, and other outside agencies as appropriate.
- Coordinates care with outpatient providers and resources to ensure a safe and effective aftercare plan.
- Provides therapeutic intervention in crisis situations.

- Master's degree in behavioral science with current CA licensure of LCSW or LMFT is required
- At least 1 year of post-master's experience in a mental health setting

- Understanding of goal setting techniques and safety planning
- High degree of knowledge and strategies for dealing with a variety of people from varying educational and socio-cultural backgrounds
